**9:15 a.m.....Laverne Brubaker Farm**- 8589 Planktown North Road, Shiloh OH. Lavern grows organic corn, soybeans, wheat and alfalfa. He has some good-looking soybeans. He has been using AgriEnergy products for years and is getting good production on his farm.

They plant non-GMO corn for corn silage and grain have been applying BioEnerG with 28% N at planting and side-dress while reducing nitrogen inputs the last 9 years and have some great looking crops. They have applied SBb 2.5 (Beauvaria bassiana) at planting to their corn and soybeans to minimize vomitoxins in their grains.

**9:00 a.m.....** Bryce Wenger Farm- 1075 North Wenger Road, Dalton OH. Bryce and his father Lynn have been using AgriEnergy products for many years and their crops keep improving. We will want to spend some time in the organic corn variety plot Bryce has planted. He used the AgriEnergy row starter, **and the plot looks very good.**

**9:45 a.m.....** Lynn Wenger Soybean Plot- 14945 East Lincoln Way, Dalton OH. Directly across from Shady Lawn Nursing Home. Lynn has planted an organic soybean variety plot planted with AgriEnergy row starter. **This is an impressive plot.** After harvest, you will receive yield information.

They have been using SPE-120 on their grain crops, and Dyna-Cure on hay. A propane flame weeder, weed zapper, camera and GPS guidance on their cultivator are utilized. Join the discussion of their farming practices and see the modern equipment and technology they use in their large-scale organic production. **Don't miss this stop.**
